

Adult Sunday Classes

Paths **All Ages**
A discussion based class for those that want to go deeper into theology and Methodist doctrine. We look at the compelling questions and issues that face us in today's world. We recognize and celebrate the individual paths by which God calls us to Him.

Covenant Class **50+**
This class engages in Bible studies and more contemporary studies that typically turn to current events. The sessions are mostly discussion based. They are also active in fellowship and in outreach ministries, including the support of Prison Ministries.

Open Door to the Good News **60+**
A small, discussion-based group that studies a variety of topics. The class is led by two rotating teachers.

Friendship Class **50+**
You get two for one with this group. The Friendship Class also meets as the D.O.W. Group (Doers of the Word) for fellowship events. On Sunday mornings, they gather for an instructor-led, in-depth Bible study. They are very active in Christian service providing for the needs of the church and the community, especially the children.

Young Adult **20-40**
Various life stages can be found in this younger member group. This class uses discussion-based studies to engage its members in ways to relate stories of the Bible to their life. Whether you are new to the church or grew up here you'll feel welcome here. *(Starting back up soon)*

Journeys **All Ages**
This group is primarily for people who are new to Bible Study or have been away for awhile. "Journeys" uses multimedia and facilitated discussions to better understand and apply Biblical truths to our everyday lives.

Seekers Class **50+**
A very active class made up of a wide variety of ages and life situations, this class is always open to new visitors. Currently the Seekers are involved in a year-long Beth Moore study through Genesis exploring such concepts as blessing, covenant and promise.

Pairs and Spares **All Ages**
This group meets on Sunday morning for a discussion-based class led by one of two class leaders. This class is also meets at numerous other times to engage in ministries that vary from mission projects in the community to cooking for retreats and activities at the church.
