



Every year, hundreds of thousands of students in the U.S. and around the world unite to do the Famine. Revolution Youth will be joining other churches at **Kelsey Memorial on August 23-24** to participate in the 30 Hour Famine. During this lock-in, we will learn about hunger, help raise funds to help the hungry, and then go hungry ourselves for 30 hours. Through the Famine, we will grow closer to Christ and each other -- all while helping to save the lives of hungry kids. Here's some information and answers to common questions:

- The Famine begins on Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Students eat lunch at noon and begin their famine (on their own) afterwards. Everyone meets at Kelsey Memorial United Methodist Church at 6pm.
- All participants must complete a consent form.
- Water is provided throughout the Famine for students (and leaders). Students can also bring sugar-free gum—we will check if it's sugar-free!
- For medical reasons, some students (and leaders) should not fast. We just need to know beforehand if you have a student that needs to eat. We'll make arrangements with parents.
- Students must bring sleeping bags, etc. It is a lock-in. Our Famine is complete Saturday at 6:30 PM.
- Dress comfortably. There are several organized activities during the Famine. Students also participate in a service project during the Famine.
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
