

# Covid-19 Sunday School Screening

Please answer the following questions before attending Sunday School.

If your answer is yes, please stay home.

## **Have you experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 14 days?**

- Feeling feverish or having a temperature of 100.4° F (38°C) or greater
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting
- Have you or anyone you have been in close contact with, been diagnosed with Covid-19 or placed in quarantine for possible exposure within the last two weeks?
- Have you been asked to self isolate or quarantine by a medical professional or a local public health official in the last two weeks?

Sunday School is up and running at Grace UMC for all children three years old through fifth grade. It is an exciting time to finally be back in church and Sunday school after so many months of quarantine. To make that happen we have taken every precaution possible and even added a few.

We ask that all children three years old and up and all adult team members wear a face mask while in the children's area. There are hand sanitation areas all over the children's area and just outside the main door. And temperature checks will happen before anyone enters the area.

Our nursery is also open during both church services and during Sunday school for children up to three years of age.

Please read the information for Sunday school screening and answer the questions before coming to Sunday school. Our plan is to keep everyone healthy while in the church and Sunday school.
